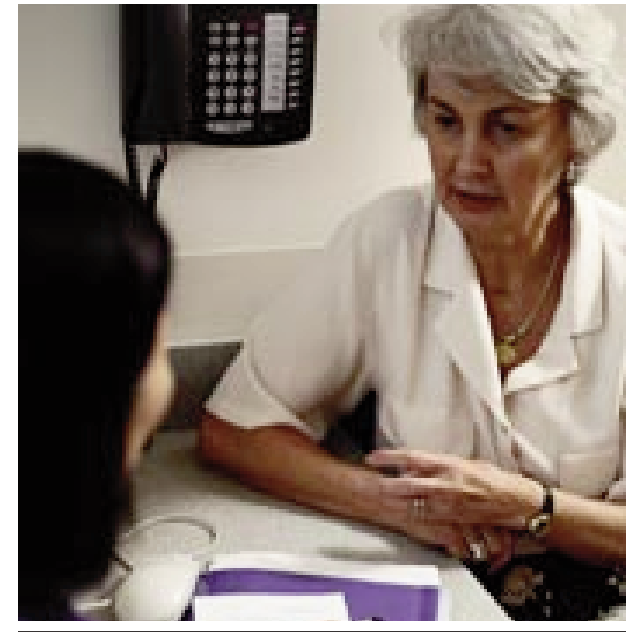

## **What is MTM?**

A group of pharmacists that work together to help people get the most from their medications.

- We talk to you about your medications and illnesses.
- We talk to your doctors to make sure the medications you take are correct and safe to take together.
- We keep track of what medications you take, and give you an up-to-date list at each visit.
- We help you talk to your insurance and get their medications.

**You will work primarily with one pharmacist who will get to know you and the medications you are taking. You can make an appointment with your MTM pharmacist when you visit your other doctors at UIC.**

## **What will MTM do for me?**

Your pharmacist will help you with your medication and your health.

- My pharmacist will explain my medications and illnesses. She will also talk about how my medicine should help me and explain possible side effects in a way that I can understand.
- My pharmacist will include my opinion in making decisions about my health care and the medicines I'm taking. She will talk to me before making changes to my prescriptions or treatment plan.
- My pharmacist will talk to all of my doctors to make sure my medicines are safe to take together.
- My pharmacist will respect me, listen to me, and keep my information confidential.

## **What do I need to do to be in the program?**

- I will get all my prescriptions filled at UIC. If a prescription is needed when the pharmacy is not open I can go to another pharmacy to get the medication.
- I will ask my doctor for prescriptions and bring them to my pharmacist.
- I will tell my pharmacist about all medications that I am taking, including vitamins, antacids, Tylenol, or herbals. I will also tell my pharmacist about any new medications.
- I will contact the clinic if I need to change my appointment. I understand that if I do not come in on time I may need to wait to be seen.
- I will treat the MTM and pharmacy staff with respect and courtesy.
