

Healthcare Merger Statistics

- Healthcare and Life Sciences M&A Survey Outlook, Becker's Hospital Review
 - 50 corporate and private equity respondents interviewed
 - 85% said they expect M&A activity to increase in healthcare in the coming year
 - 84% said they expect private equity activity to increase in relation to strategic M&As
 - 46% say top strategic drivers for M&As is building infrastructure, getting access to new technology and increased market share, and rising demand for facility and equipment improvement




2014 Financial Performance of Medicare ACOs

- 20 Pioneer & 333 Medicare Shared Savings Participants
- ❖Generated \$411M in total savings
- ❖5 Pioneer (25%) lost money and owe CMS \$9M
- ❖ Pioneer ACO program has lost 40% of its participants




Shrinking Supply of Healthcare Providers






