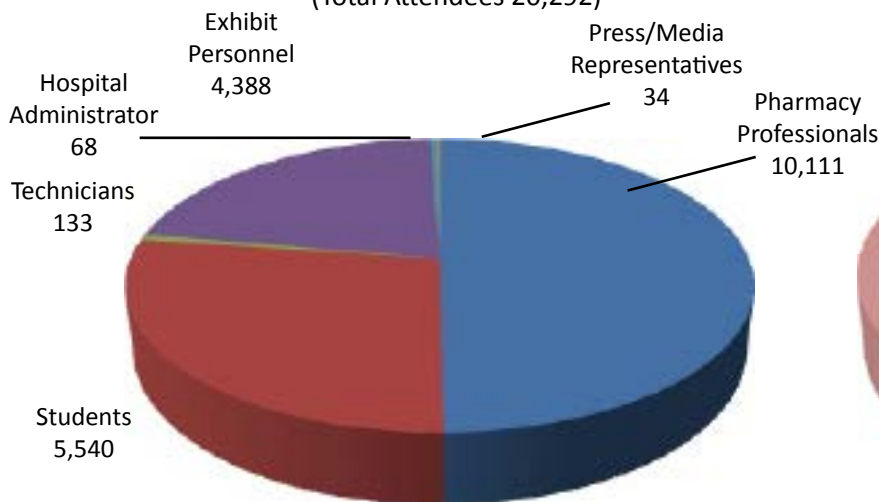

Attendance by Pharmacy Professional Categories

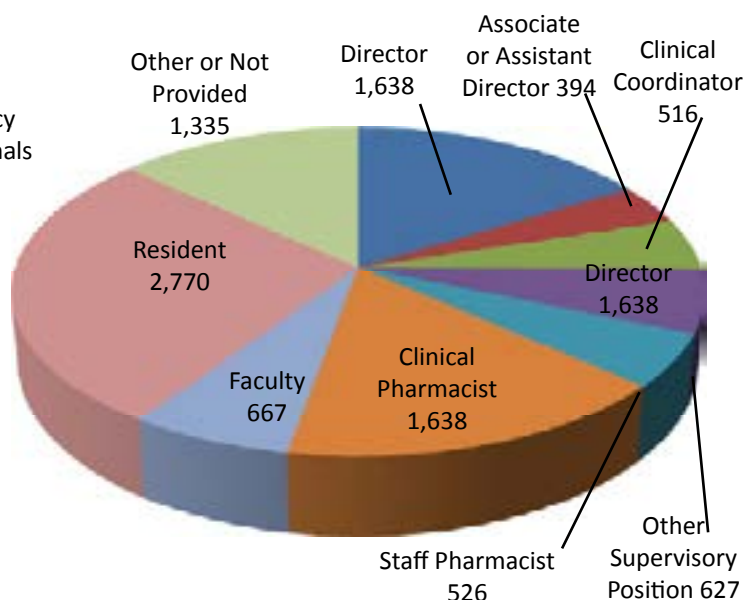
